

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WHITBY

BY-LAW NO. 6018-08

BEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT THE HOURS OF ACCESS TO BAYCLIFFE PARK DURING THE WINTER MONTHS

WHEREAS, Municipal Councils have the authority under the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25, as amended, to pass by-laws within the sphere of culture, parks, recreation and heritage respecting the health, safety and well-being of persons and the protection of persons and property;

AND WHEREAS, the Municipality of the Town of Whitby has passed a by-law to regulate and control the use of public parks and park buildings as set out in By-law 5066-02;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby considers it appropriate to pass a by-law to regulate and control the use of Baycliffe Park during the winter months;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 5066-02 be amended by adding thereto the following subsection 2.(2):
Notwithstanding clause 2.(b), no person except a person acting under the authority of a permit issued by the Director of Community and Marketing Services and/or his or her designate, shall enter into or remain in Baycliffe Park between the hours of 8:00 p.m. local time in the afternoon and 6:00 a.m. local time in the forenoon from the 1st day of October to the 31st day of March, inclusive, in any calendar year.

BY-LAW READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 28th DAY OF JANUARY, A.D., 2008.
