

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WHITBY

BY-LAW NO. 5680-05

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND LICENCING BY-LAW NO. 5545-04 TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN TAXI-CAB FARES

WHEREAS, Section 150 of the Municipal Act, 2001, chapter 25, provides that by-laws may be passed by councils for licencing, regulating and governing owners and drivers of cabs or other vehicles used for hire or any class or classes thereof and for establishing the rates or fares to be charged by the owners or drivers of such vehicles for the conveyance of goods or passengers either wholly within the municipality or to any point beyond its limits;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby has passed By-law No. 5545-04 to provide for the licencing, regulating and governing of various callings, businesses, trades and occupations;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the said Corporation considers it advisable to amend the provisions of By-law No. 5545-04, as amended, relating to taxi-cab fares;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby enacts as follows:

1. Subsection 6(1) of Schedule "7" to By-law No. 5545-04, as amended, is revoked and the following substituted therefor:
 - 6.(1) Except as otherwise provided in this by-law, no taxi-cab driver licenced under this by-law including the driver of an accessible taxicab, shall charge a rate or fare for the conveyance of goods or passengers either wholly within the Corporation or to any point not more than five (5) kilometres beyond the limits of the Corporation, except in accordance with the following:


- (a) \$3.00 plus .10 for each one-sixteenth (1/16) kilometre (G.S.T. included); and,
- (b) .10 for each twelve (12) seconds of waiting time while under engagement (G.S.T. included);

it being understood that nothing in this by-law shall prevent a taxicab driver from charging a lesser rate or fare.

EFFECTIVE DATE

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of November, 2005.
