

**2010 FINAL TAX BILL**  
**Residential, Farmland, Pipeline and Managed Forest Properties**

The first installment of the Final Tax Billing for 2010 for the above noted properties is due on:

**June 15, 2010**

These Final tax bills were mailed May 25, 2010. If you did not receive a tax bill and you are responsible for payment, please contact the Tax Department at 905-430-4304 or 905-668-5803 to obtain the necessary information.

Payments not received by **June 15, 2010** are subject to a penalty charge of 1.25% on the first day of default and the first day of each calendar month so long as non-payment continues

Payment can be made:

- 1) Pre-Authorized Payment Plan - visit our website at [www.whitby.ca](http://www.whitby.ca) or call the Municipal Offices for more information;
- 2) By Internet or Telephone banking, please inquire at your financial institution; (It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure the correct information, including roll number is used for these transactions. The Town of Whitby is not responsible for correcting payment errors made by the taxpayer.);
- 3) At participating Financial Institutions, (payment stub is required if paying at your financial institution); if paying using this method, please remember to allow sufficient time for processing between the bank and our offices to avoid any inconvenience;
- 4) By mail to the Town of Whitby, 575 Rossland Road East, Whitby ON, L1N 2M8 (When mailing payment, the taxpayer assumes responsibility for late arrival of payment and any penalty/interest charges that may apply);
- 5) Post dated cheques are acceptable;
- 6) In person at Municipal Offices, 575 Rossland Road East Whitby, ON - by Cash, Cheque or Debit only; **PLEASE BRING IN YOUR TAX BILL SO THAT WE CAN STAMP THE BACK OF THE BILL FOR YOUR OFFICIAL RECEIPT.**
- 7) After hours "outside" mail slot at the above address. (DO NOT DEPOSIT CASH)

If paying by cheque - please make cheque **payable to the "Town of Whitby"** and write the property tax roll number(s) on the front of the cheque. All cheques that are not honoured by your financial institution, for any reason, will be subject to an administration fee.
