



Whitby Official Plan Review

The Whitby Official Plan is a key planning document comprising general principles and policies intended to guide and control future land use development and redevelopment, while safeguarding significant natural features and rural areas. It provides a general policy direction and land use planning framework to guide the physical, social, economic and environmental management and growth of the Town.

The *Planning Act* and the Town of Whitby Official Plan require that an Official Plan Review must be undertaken, not less frequently than every five years, to ensure that it: conforms to, or does not conflict with provincial plans; has regard for matters of provincial interest; and, is consistent with Provincial Policy Statement, 2005, the Greenbelt Plan, the Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe, the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan, and the Durham Region Official Plan.
